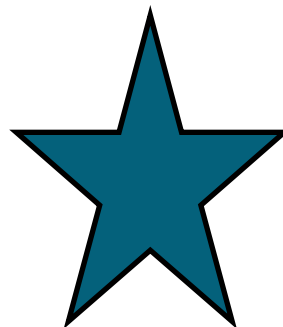
## Before School Sport
